> The number of patients with multiple illnesses is increasing in more and more medical practices. Unfortunately, multimorbidity is no longer limited to old age, as more and more young people are also suffering from complex diseases. Very often, dysbiosis with a variety of pathogenic microorganisms can be detected in these patients, most commonly viruses and bacteria. These chronic microbial infections are often causally involved in the disease process. Due to immunological cross-reactions, such persistent infections can even develop into autoimmune diseases. One goal of therapy should therefore also be the elimination of chronic foci of infection.

To re-sensitize the immune system to specific pathogens, SANUM therapy uses SANUKEHL[®] preparations. Each of these contains an extract of special bacterial or fungal strains produced according to a proprietary formulation. In total, there are 13 different SANUKEHL[®] preparations, eleven from different bacteria and two preparations from fungi.

But how do you choose the right preparation? If the pathogen is known, the selection is often not a problem. It is only problematic if no SANUKEHL[®] preparation is available which contains, for example, the same bacterial strain which is also the cause of the disease.

In these cases, it is worthwhile to classify the pathogen a little and use the SANUKEHL[®] preparation of a closely related bacterium/fungus. But what if no pathogen is known? In this case, the disease itself or the patient's medical history will often give you clues as to which SANUKEHL[®] preparation is well suited.

Example: patients with joint inflammation/rheumatism

Various microorganisms can lead to joint inflammation/rheumatism, sometimes a long time after the primary infection (which often had nothing to do with the musculoskeletal system at all). These include, for example, infections with Streptococci, Borrelia, Yersinia, Salmonella or with bacteria of the species Proteus. Perhaps the patient shows an indication of a corresponding infection. The appropriate SANUKEHL® preparations for therapy are SANUKEHL® Strep (Streptococci), SANUKEHL® Brucel (Borrelia), SANUKEHL® Salm (Yersinia, Salmonella) and SANUKEHL® Prot (bacteria of the genus Proteus). If too many SANUKEHL® preparations are being considered, start with the most frequently occurring pathogen or the pathogen that is most likely to cause the disease. If several pathogens come into consideration, the various SANUKEHL® preparations are used in daily alternation.

Within the framework of SANUM therapy, the SANUKEHL® preparations are a component of a holistic therapy concept and are very rarely used alone in therapy. Those who wish can deepen this topic in Basic Module 2, where the SANUKEHL® preparations are discussed in detail in theory and practice.

> For pain and inflammatory processes in the joints, the patient can now also be supported with a 10% CBD oil. The cannabidiol (CBD) used for this oil from the company SANUM-Kehlbeck is a crystalline powder of plant and tested origin with a purity of at least 99.8%.
